**Who?** People who love the small towns of Northeast Kansas and want to see the caring community lifestyle continue for future generations.

**What?** We are building a Community Fund for the Caring Community Foundation. The Community Fund will exist into perpetuity, providing support for emerging community needs and fundamental operating costs of the Caring Community Foundation.

As of May 2019, the Caring Community Foundation has been entrusted with the stewardship of 24 funds amounting to over \$1 Million. These funds each provide charitable support to specific identified community needs including scholarship, education, sports, healthcare, and other kinds of community assistance. The Caring Community Foundation helps keep resources in our communities and helps put resources to work in our communities. We're just getting started. We have an annual grant campaign for community revitalization and last year we awarded over \$13,000 for grants and scholarships. We need to grow our Community Fund to generate support for operations and emerging community needs. Individually, our efforts may seem small but together we can help secure the future for our communities.

We need **100 People Who Care** for the rural communities in Pottawatomie, Marshall, Nemaha and Jackson Counties, to commit to donating \$4000 within four years; that will get us to \$400,000 for an endowed permanent fund that will be put to work for our communities forever. Right now we are almost halfway there.

Donations are tax deductible and there will be public recognition, but these 100 individuals or organizations are special people, people with heart, committed to their hometown communities and to protecting hometown resources for future generations.
