CARING COMMUNITY FOUNDATION AWARDS NEARLY \$10,000 TO LOCAL NON-PROFITS

Four local non-profit groups have received grants from the Caring Community Foundation. HRHS Havensville Community Center was awarded \$3,000 for new flooring in their entryway. Community HealthCare System received \$1,350 for mental health awareness training for community members. The City of Onaga received \$5,000 for a new and improved basketball court. The Onaga Historical Society was awarded \$275 for supplies and mannequins for displays.

“The Caring Community Foundation exists to help support a positive future for our small local communities in and around Pottawatomie County,” explained Executive Director, Susie Kufahl, “we host our annual community grant cycle every summer.”

The grants were made from the CCF Community Fund with additional support from the Wayne Stallard Family Fund, Bluestem Electric and Co-Bank .
